Dear Mr. Hayden:

Here is a brief summary of the recent activities of the members of the French staff who are now in the national service.

Professor Justin O'Brien is now Major Justin O'Brien and continues to be attached to the O.S.S. He is now stationed in Paris.

Dr. Ian Fraser is now Captain Ian Fraser and is in service overseas in Aviation. I know that he has been in Great Britain and I have heard that he has lately gone to France, but this last I cannot positively affirm.

Dr. Wilbur M. Frohock has been promoted from Lt. (j.g.) to Lt. and continues to be at the Great Lakes Naval Training Station where he is now in charge of a battalion of 11 hundred men.

Dr. Donald M. Frame has been promoted from Lt. (j.g.) to Lt. and is now at the Naval Auxiliary Air Station in Manteo, North Carolina.

Dr. Otis E. Fellows went overseas in the spring in the civilian service of the O.W.I. and has since then been stationed in London.

Dr. Simon J. Copans also left in January 1944 for service overseas in the O.W.I. He entered Paris on the very first day of the liberation of that city and is now stationed in Paris.
